



**A Pig**





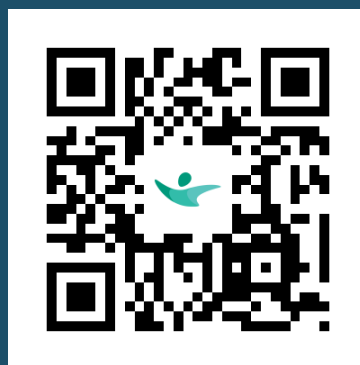

Women like Nanbam from Nigeria love raising pigs because they reproduce quickly and provide women with significant funds when sold at the market. Nanbam shared:

*“I chose piggery as my vocational skill and thanks to Women for Women International’s stipend was able to save money to buy two pigs. My plan is to fatten them up and breed them, so I can give them to other women. I want to help them, the way that I have been helped.”*
