Standing with a woman survivor of war is so much more than financial support – it is a powerful message of hope and strength that you are sending to women living in some of the world’s most dangerous places.

How does it work?

You will be directly matched with a woman survivor of war as she enrolls in Women for Women International’s Stronger Women, Stronger Nations programme. Your ‘sister’ will learn about her health and wellbeing, how to earn and save money alongside a vocational skill, and learn about her rights – all in a classroom with 24 other women, breaking the isolation caused by conflict.

You’ll receive a welcome pack in the post introducing you to your sister, with information about who she is and where she is from. Through our online support area, you will be able to send messages of support to your sister and we will send you regular email updates about her progress as she gains the skills to create a brighter future for herself and her family.



Marie is one of Women for Women International's Stronger Women, Stronger Nations graduates from the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Marie is changing the way her community treats people with disabilities, one soap bar at a time. She shared:
